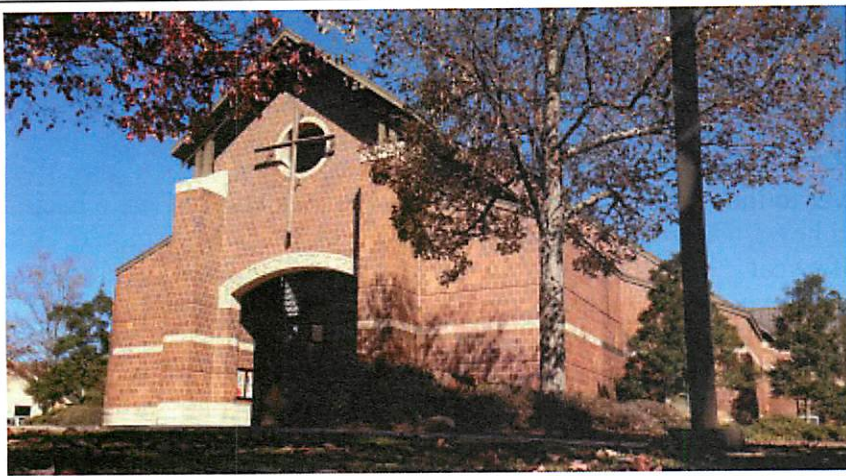

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

V Sunday in Ordinary Time

Job 7:1-4, 6-7; 1 Corinthians 9:16-19, 22-23; Mark 1:29-39

The story is told of a little boy and his father. They were walking along a road when they came across a large stone. The boy looked at the stone and thought about it a little. Then he asked his father, "Do you think if I use all my strength, I can move that rock?" The father thought for a moment and said, "I think that if you use all your strength, you can do it."

That was all the little boy needed. He ran over to the rock and began to push on it. He pushed and he pushed, so hard did he try that little beads of sweat appeared on his forehead. But the rock didn't move — not an inch, not half an inch.

After a while, the little boy sat down on the ground. His face had fallen. His whole body seemed to be just a lump there on the earth. "You were wrong," he told his dad. "I can't do it."

His father walked over to him, knelt beside him, and put his arm around the boy's shoulder. "You can do it," he said. "You just didn't use all your strength. You didn't ask me to help."

The world in which we live tells us that it is all up to us. It tells us that we have to be strong and independent. It tells us we can't and shouldn't count on anyone or anything else. And yet, what faith tells us that we have a ready resource in God, strength for those who ask. Asking God is our strength, prayer is our power. There is power in the name of Jesus.

Jesus continued his journey of healing the sick and restoring good health to everyone. The same Lord is active and alive today.

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

V Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Job 7: 1-4, 6-7; 1 Corintios 9: 16-19, 22-23; San Marcos 1: 29-39

Se cuenta la historia de un niño y su padre. Caminaban por un camino cuando se encontraron con una gran piedra. El niño miró la piedra y pensó un poco en ella. Luego le preguntó a su padre: "¿Crees que si uso todas mis fuerzas, podré mover esa piedra?" El padre pensó por un momento y dijo: "Creo que si usas todas tus fuerzas, puedes hacerlo".

Eso era todo lo que necesitaba el niño. Corrió hacia la roca y comenzó a empujarla. Empujó y empujó, con tanta fuerza que lo intentó que pequeñas gotas de sudor aparecieron en su frente. Pero la roca no se movió, ni una pulgada, ni media pulgada.

Después de un rato, el niño se sentó en el suelo. Su rostro había caído. Todo su cuerpo parecía ser solo un bulto en la tierra. "Estabas equivocado", le dijo a su padre. "No puedo hacerlo".

Su padre se acercó a él, se arrodilló a su lado y rodeó el hombro del niño con el brazo. "Puedes hacerlo", dijo. "Simplemente no usaste todas tus fuerzas. No me pediste ayuda".

El mundo en el que vivimos nos dice que todo depende de nosotros. Nos dice que tenemos que ser fuertes e independientes. Nos dice que no podemos y no debemos contar con nadie ni con nada más. Y, sin embargo, la fe nos dice que tenemos un recurso disponible en Dios, fuerza para quienes lo piden. Pedirle a Dios es nuestra fuerza, la oración es nuestro poder. Hay poder en el nombre de Jesús.

Jesús continuó su camino de curar a los enfermos y restaurar la buena salud a todos. El mismo Señor está activo y vivo hoy.
